Just remember that you need to have successfully competed in your nominated Division on at least 3 NSWRWC Competition Days prior to the event (not including NSW Athletics State Championships or Canberra Federation Event). Saturday 27th July is the Postal Challenge day. It is conducted by Racewalking Australia and is a RWA club versus club competition with points being awarded within each race to the top finisher for each club. We compete against clubs from all of the 10 interstate clubs in our Walking Federation. We look forward to dominating this event as we did in Canberra. As it is an Australia wide competition it takes a few weeks for every RWA Club to send in their results and then the winning Club to be declared!

We look forward to everyone's involvement as the more walkers who compete the better our overall results will be and apart from that it is a normal weekend of competition with points being allocated for fastest and handicap.

NO registration or entry fee is required for this event!

<u>Saturday 27th July</u> is the last day for our pointscore as it finishes at the conclusion of competition on this day.

CONGRATULATIONS to Kirsten Crocker on being selected as a Walk Judge Official for the Paris Olympics! There are only two other Australian Athletic Officials selected to officiate at these Games.
